In certain circumstances, to have your personal data provided to you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and, where feasible, to have that data transmitted to another controller;

To object to processing to perform a public function, or that is based on legitimate interests; except where there are compelling reasons for us to continue e.g. in the public interest:

To object to processing for purposes of direct marketing. Please note that the Parish does not use your personal data for direct marketing purposes; To object to processing solely for historical or scientific purposes;

Not to be subject to decisions based solely on automated processing that produces legal effects or similarly significantly affects you. Please note that the Parish does not process your personal data in this way.
