NOMINATION MEETING

Notice is hereby given that a Nomination Meeting will be held at St Mary's Parish Hall on Wednesday 10th March 2021 at 8.30pm:

To elect one Procureur du Bien Public for the remainder of a 3 year term of office expiring 12th March 2023

In each election:

- if there are more candidates than vacancies, a poll will be held on **Wednesday 31st March 2021**
- if there are not more candidates than vacancies, any duly nominated candidate will be declared elected at the nomination meeting

The closing date for registering to vote in each election is midday on the day BEFORE the nomination meeting (**12pm Tuesday 9th March 2021**).

A nomination form for each candidate for election must be produced to the meeting and must be completed by a proposer and 9 seconders who are electors in the parish.

All electors are welcome to attend, however, in line with current Government guidelines we are restricted to 10 attendees per meeting on the night, so please register your attendance by telephoning the Parish office on 482700 by 9th March 2021.
