**MINUTES OF ELECTORAL MEETING
HELD AT ST MARY'S PARISH HALL
On Thursday 12th August 2021 AT 8.15PM**

Pursuant to a certain Act of the Royal Court, dated 23rd July 2021, it was ordered that an election be held on 8th September 2021 to fill the office of Centenier in the Parish of St Mary, the term of office of Centenier Mark Evans (Chef de Police) being due to expire.

An Assembly of the Electors of the Parish of St Mary was held at the Parish Hall on Thursday 12th August at 8.15pm to proceed with the said nomination:

- Elect one Centenier to complete a 3-year term of office commencing 10th September 2021.

The Connétable, John Le Bailly, opened the meeting by welcoming all. Apologies were given by Centenier Chris Bunt, Centenier John Alcock, and Tony Gilbert.

The Secretary read the Notice.

The meeting was attended by 17 people who were eligible to vote.

The Connétable advised the assembly that this position had become vacant due to the forthcoming expiry of Mark Evans's current term of office.

The Connétable asked for nominations for the vacant position of Centenier, and Mick Rondel proposed Centenier Mark Evans for re-election as Centenier, advising that he had known Mark for several years, and was confident that he could fulfil the position. The proposal was seconded by: Prudence Vibert, Richard Sowerby, Anthony Gilbert, Alan Moullin, Alan Jolley, George Durell, Marilyn Evans, Sally Langlois, and Colin Huelin.

Only one candidate was proposed for the vacancy.

The duration of the Assembly exceeded the minimum time required by Law, and the Connétable declared Mark Evans duly elected for a further term of three years, and advised him to appear before the Royal Court to be sworn in, (possibly via video link) on Friday 10th September 2021 at 10am.

The Connétable congratulated Centenier Evans (Chef de Police) on his re-election and thanked him for standing again, and for his continued commitment and dedication to the Parish of St Mary.

The Connétable declared the meeting closed at 8.30pm
