MINUTES OF A NOMINATION MEETING HELD AT ST MARY'S PARISH HALL On Thursday 12th March 2021 AT 8.00PM

Pursuant to a certain Act of the Royal Court, dated 23rd July 2021, it was ordered that an election be held on 8th September 2021 to fill the following:

- Procureur du Bien Public for a 3 year term of office commencing 10th September 2021

Pursuant to Article 19 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002, Notice was given that a Nomination Meeting of the Electors of the Parish of St Mary would be held at St Mary's Parish Hall on Thursday 12th August 2021 to proceed with the said nomination.

The Connétable, John Le Bailly, opened the meeting by welcoming all. Apologies were given by Centenier Chris Bunt, Centenier John Alcock, and Tony Gilbert.

The Parish Secretary read the Notice convening the meeting.

The meeting was attended by 17 people who were eligible to vote.

The Connétable invited nominations for the vacant position of Procureur du Bien Public, Proposer: David Munns addressed the Assembly highlighting that it was a privilege to propose Peter Le Rossignol who wished to stand for the position of Procureur du Bien Public, he then went on to say that Peter is a long-standing Parishioner who has in the past served the Parish within the Honorary Police, and as a Rates Assessor, and in addition has also successfully run his own business for 50 years. David advised that he was very confident that Peter together with the other Procureur du Bien Public would ensure that the affairs of the Parish would be well scrutinised.

The nomination was seconded by: Derek Maltwood, Michael Pinchard, David Langlois, Laura Pittman, Gillian Arthur, Joan Godel, Donalda Macleod, Martin de Gruchy, and Derek Le Brun.

The Constable thanked David Munns for his Proposal, and following a brief discussion, the mandatory 10 minutes was allowed to lapse and no further nominees came forward.

As no further nominations were received the Connétable congratulated Peter Le Rossignol and declared him Procureur du Bien Public, and advised that he appear before the Royal Court (possibly via video link at the Parish Hall) on Friday 10th September 2021 at 10am to be sworn in.

The Connétable declared the meeting closed at 8.14pm.
