



PARISH OF ST MARY

**MINUTES OF THE PARISH ASSEMBLY
HELD AT ST MARY'S PARISH HALL
ON THURSDAY 12th NOVEMBER 2020 AT 8.15PM**

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary was held at the Parish Hall on Thursday 12th November 2020 at 8.15pm to conduct the following business:

1. In accordance with Article 32 of the Rates (Jersey) Law, 2005, elect a Rates Assessor for 3 years arising on 31st December 2020 to 31st December 2023.
2. In accordance with Article 32 of the Rates (Jersey) Law, 2005, elect a Rates Assessor to complete the term of office to 31st December 2022.

The meeting was attended by 13 people who were eligible to vote.

The Connétable advised the Assembly that Robin Stockton had indicated his wishes to serve another term of office as Rates Assessor. He stated that the work of the Rates Assessor goes greatly unseen and he was glad of his expertise in this role.

The Connétable asked for nominations for the vacancy of a 3 year term of office as Rates Assessor, only one candidate stepped forward.

The Connétable requested a proposer for the re-election of Robin Stockton.

The proposer was Ivor Barrette and the seconder was David Munns.

The Connétable thanked Robin Stockton for his work to date, and declared him as duly elected for a further 3 year term of office up to December 2023.

The Connétable then continued, and advised the Assembly that following the sad passing of Christine Rimbault a Rate Assessor was required to serve the remaining term of office up to to 31st December 2022.

The Connétable asked for nominations for the remaining term of office as Rates Assessor, only one candidate stepped forward, Cynthia Cotillard. The Connétable requested a proposer for the election of Cynthia Cotillard.

The proposer was Martin de Gruchy, he highlighted that Cynthia Cotillard would be a very good candidate as she did so much work for the Parish and the seconder was Barbara Le Bailly.

There being no other nominations, the Connétable declared Cynthia Cotillard duly elected, and warned both elected candidates to attend St Mary's Parish Hall to appear before the Royal Court to be sworn in, via video link, on Friday 11 December 2020 at 10am.
