**MINUTES OF ELECTORAL MEETING
HELD AT ST MARY'S PARISH HALL
On 12th NOVEMBER 2020 AT 8PM**

An Assembly of the Electors of the Parish of St Mary was held at the Parish Hall on Thursday 12th November 2020 at 8pm in order to:

Elect one Centenier to complete a 3 year term of office expiring 15 December 2023.

The Connétable, John Le Bailly, opened the meeting by welcoming all.

The meeting was attended by 13 people who were eligible to vote.

The Connétable advised the assembly that this position had become vacant due to the forthcoming expiry of Glynn Grant Bower's current term of office (15 December 2020).

The Connétable asked for nominations for the vacant position of Centenier, and Mick Rondel proposed Centenier Glynn Grant Bower for re-election as Centenier, the proposal was seconded by Centeniers John Alcock, and Chris Bunt.

Only one candidate was proposed for the vacancy.

The duration of the Assembly exceeded the minimum time required by Law, and the Connétable declared Glynn Bower duly elected for a further term of three years and warned him to attend St Marys Parish Hall to appear before the Royal Court to be sworn in, via video link on Friday 11 December 2020 at 10am.

The Connétable congratulated Centenier Bower on his re-election and thanked him for standing again, and for his continued commitment and dedication to the Parish of St Mary.

The Connétable declared the meeting closed at 8.15pm.
