MINUTES OF A PARISH ASSEMBLY
HELD AT ST MARY'S PARISH HALL
On MONDAY 24TH FEBRUARY AT 7.30PM

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary was held at St Mary's Parish Hall on Monday 24th February 2020 at 7.30pm to conduct the following business:

1. Receive and if approved, adopt the Minutes of the Parish Assembly held on Wednesday 12th February 2020.
2. To take into consideration the application of the under-mentioned who desire to be recommended to the Licensing Assembly for the grant of a liquor licence;

The Connétable, John Le Bailly, opened the meeting by welcoming all.

Apologies were received from Rev Canon Tim Neill.

The meeting was attended by 6 people.

The Parish Secretary read the convening notice to the Assembly.

1. The Minutes of the previous Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary held on 12th February were not adopted as no parishioners were present who had attended the said Assembly. These Minutes will be presented again at the next Parish Assembly.
2. The Connétable advised the Assembly that he had received a licensing application for a sixth category from Samuel Pierce for the following business:

Name of Business: Pierce & E Le Dain Food & Beverage Company Limited
Business Address: Tombette Farm, La Rue D'Olive, St Mary

The Connétable advised this business included the manufacturing and storing of vodka, gin and rum. No retail licence is sought only wholesale production will be made. It was confirmed that the business operation would not create additional traffic through the Parish. The Connétable further advised this business would not be detrimental to the Parish and is an alternative to the farming industry.

The application was proposed by Tyrone Le Feuvre and seconded by Flavio Martins.

A show of hands resulted in a unanimous vote for this application to proceed to the Licensing Assembly. The Connétable advised Samuel Pierce to appear before the Licensing Assembly in the Royal Court at 10am on Thursday 19th March.

The Connétable declared the meeting closed at 7.40pm.
