**NOMINATION MEETING**

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary was held at St Mary's Parish Hall, on **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at 7.00pm:**

To elect one Procureur du Bien Public to complete the term of office of Peter Le Rossignol, Procureurs du Bien Public of the Parish of St Mary for the remainder of a 3 year term of office expiring September 2024

The Connétable, John Le Bailly, opened the meeting by welcoming all and the Parish Secretary Mrs Anne Proffitt, read the Notice convening the meeting.

The Meeting was attended by 10 (9 who were eligible to vote)

The Connétable advised that one nomination paper for this office had been received from Cynthia Cotillard and thanked her for putting her name forward

The nomination was proposed by Martin De Gruchy, who advised the Assembly that Cynthia has served the parish over many years and is currently a Rates Assessor also a member of the St Mary's Ladies Circle. Cynthia has in the past been involved with St Marys Honorary Police, Brownies, Guides, St Mary's Community Centre (booking officer) and been awarded the J.E.P neighbour of the year. With her vast experience in banking (27 years) she will be an asset to the Parish.

The nomination was seconded by Shirley De Gruchy, Barbara de la Haye, Thomas Park, Joan Godel, Mary Brooks, Alan Le Breton, Heather Woods, Michael Rondel, and Simon Gavey.

Following a brief discussion, the mandatory 10 minutes was allowed to lapse, and no further nominations came forward.

There being no other candidates for the position of Procureur du Bien Public, Cynthia Cotillard was declared appointed to the position, having been unanimously elected.

As no further nomination were received the Connétable congratulated Cynthia Cotillard and declared her Procureur du Bien Public for St Marys, and warned her to appear before the Royal Court on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at 10 am to be sworn in.

The Connetable declared the meeting closed at 7.29
