**Minutes of a Parish Assembly held at**  
**St Marys Parish Hall on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at 7.30pm**

**NOMINATION MEETING**

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary was held at St Mary's Parish Hall on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at 7.30pm to conduct the following business:

To elect one Centenier to complete the term of office of Centenier Mark Evans, which is due to expire 10th September 2024.

The Parish Secretary read the Notice convening the meeting.

The Connétable, John Le Bailly, opened the meeting by welcoming all.

The Meeting was attended by 10 who were eligible to vote.

The Connétable highlighted to all in attendance at the Assembly that Mr Mark Evans, wished to relinquish his position for personal reasons, and that permission had been sought by the Royal Court to do so, requesting that a replacement be appointed to serve the remaining 3-year term of office which concludes in September 2024.

The Connétable advised that one nomination paper for this office had been received from an experienced Constable Officer, Jim (James) Drew who has served the Parish and has held the Centenier position for several years in the past.

The nomination was proposed by Chris Bunt who advised the Assembly that Jim has been a Constable Officer since 2008 with St Mary's Honorary Police, also holding a position of Centenier for several years in the Parish, with his wealth of experience in his new position as Centenier he will be an asset to the Parish.

The nomination was seconded by Deputy David (Robert) Johnson, Peter Le Rossignol, Alan Rimeur, Brian Curtis, Pamela Curtis, Caroline Holmes, Jeremy Holmes, David Munns and Ms Sue Heppolette.

The Connétable thanked Mark Evans for his length of service to the Parish and wished him well for the future.

Following a brief discussion, the mandatory 10 minutes was allowed to lapse, and no further nominees came forward.

As no further nominations were received the Connétable congratulated Jim Drew and declared him Centenier, and warned him to appear before the Royal Court on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at 10 am to be sworn in

The Connétable declared the meeting closed at 7.48pm
