

## NOMINATION MEETING

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary was held at St Mary's Parish Hall, on **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at 7.45pm** 

To elect one Procureur du Bien Public to complete the term of office of Helen Mills, Procureurs du Bien Public of the Parish of St Mary for the remainder of a 3 year term of office expiring March 2023

The Connétable, John Le Bailly, opened the meeting by welcoming all and the Parish Secretary Mrs Anne Proffitt, read the Notice convening the meeting. The Meeting was attended by 25

The Connétable advised that one nomination paper for this office had been received from David Ian Munns and thanked him for putting his name forward

The nomination was proposed by Mr James Drew, who advised the Assembly that David is a true gentleman who has integrity and diligence with his vast experience he is delighted to nominate him as Procureurs du Bien Public which he has served this role before and numerous parish roles in his capacity over a decade of years. David is presently serving the Parish as a Rates assessor.

The nomination was seconded by Pamela Gallichan, Anthony Gilbert, Shirley De Gruchy, Barbara De la Haye, Juliette Gallichan, Glynn Bower, Michael Rondel, Martin De Gruchy, and Brian Curtis

David Munns made a speech about how upset he is with what is happening in his Parish and concerned how divided the Parish has become. He spoke about serving the new Connétable to the best of his ability and thanked his proposer and seconders in trusting him in giving him a chance to serve in the Parish again as Procureur du Bien Public. David also thanked the Connétable John le Bailly, for his role as Connétable, over the past 4 years.

Following a brief discussion, the mandatory 10 minutes was allowed to lapse, and no further nominations came forward.

There being no other candidates for the position of Procureur du Bien Public, David Ian Munns was declared appointed to the position, having been unanimously elected.

As no further nomination were received the Connétable congratulated David Munns and declared him Procureur du Bien Public for St Marys, and warned him to appear before the Royal Court on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 at 10 am to be sworn in.
