MINUTES OF THE NOMINATION MEETING
HELD AT ST MARY'S PARISH HALL
On the 9th February 2023 at 8pm

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary was held at St Mary's Parish Hall, on **Tuesday 9TH February 2023 at 8pm.**

To elect one Centenier and one Procureur du Bien Public to complete a 3 year term of office expiring March 2026.

The Connétable, David Johnson, opened the meeting by welcoming all and the Parish Secretary Sam de Gruchy, read the Notice convening the meeting.

The Meeting was attended by 18 people (16 of whom were eligible to vote).

Chef de Police, Chris Bunt, stood to confirm the nomination of John Alcock to continue yet another term of office as Centenier for St. Mary's. Chris Bunt noted that John had been an Honorary Police Officer since 1999 and that John provides a valuable service to the Parish of St Mary at the highest level. Chris Bunt also confirmed that he has seen John Alcock's Nomination paper and it had been submitted correctly to include one proposer and nine seconders. He concluded that he is delighted that John has agreed to continue for another term at Centenier.

John Alcock's Nomination paper was proposed by Paul Ashworth and seconded by Caroline Ashworth, Daniel Reed, Sarah Reed, Stephen Parker, Nicola Parker, Alison Dryland, Graham Dryland, Terence Gallichan and Juliette Gallichan.

The Connétable declared that, with no other nominations having been received, John Alcock was duly elected as Centenier and he was requested to attend court to be sworn in on Friday 10th March 2023.

Centenier Jim Drew stood to confirm the nomination of David Munns to continue as Procureur for another 3-year term for the Parish of St. Mary. He commented on David's enthusiasm and calibre for the role being second to none, and that the Parish is delighted that he has agreed to stand again.

David Munns had submitted a correctly filed Nomination paper with one proposer and nine seconders. His was nominated by James Drew and seconded by Glynn Bower, Christopher Bunt, Anthony Gilbert, Barbara de la Haye, Shirley de Gruchy, Pamela Gallichan, Juliette Gallichan, Terence Gallichan and Monica Moore.

The Connétable declared that, with no other nominations having been received, David Munns was duly elected as Procureur du Bien Public. He was requested to attend court to be sworn in on Friday 10th March 2023.
