**MINUTES OF NOMINATION MEETING
HELD AT ST MARY'S PARISH HALL
On 6th NOVEMBER 2023 AT 7PM**

Pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court, dated 13th October 2023, it had been ordered that an election be held on 13th December 2023 to fill the following Parish role:

- Centenier for a 3-year term of office expiring December 2026

Pursuant to Article 19 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002, Notice had been given that a Nomination Meeting of the Electors of the Parish of St Mary would be held at St Mary's Parish Hall on Monday 6th November at 7pm to receive nominations for the role.

The Connétable opened the Meeting by welcoming all. The Meeting was attended by 12 people who were confirmed as Electors in the Parish.

The Connétable advised the Meeting that this post of Centenier would become vacant on the expiry of Centenier Glynn Bower's current term of office in December 2023.

The Connétable asked for nominations for the role of Centenier, for the three-year term ending in December, 2026. Mr Glynn Bower was proposed by Mr Tim de Gruchy and a duly completed Nomination Form was submitted to the Meeting. The Secretary confirmed that it had been correctly completed and that the Proposer and Seconders had been verified as Electors in the Parish. The Connétable read out the names of Mr Bower's Seconders. No other nominations were presented.

The duration of the Meeting exceeded the minimum time required by Law, and the Connétable declared Mr Glynn Grant Bower duly elected for a further term of three years and warned him to attend at the Royal Court on Friday 15 December 2023 at 10am to swear the customary oath.

The Connétable congratulated Mr Bower on his re-election and thanked him for standing again, and for his continued service and commitment to the Parish.

The Connétable declared the meeting closed at 7.15pm.
