Minutes of an Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary held at St Mary's Parish Hall on Wednesday 27th August 2025 at 7 pm.

WELCOME

The Connétable, David Johnson, opened the meeting by welcoming those present. The notice convening the meeting was taken as read. The meeting was attended by three persons who were eligible to vote and Mr Rodolphe Mangematin representing Fuel Supplies (CI) Ltd.

1. Consider Licensing Application – Fuel Supplies (CI) Ltd

An application for a Sixth Category (Off) Licence had been made relating to the St Mary's filling Station. Under the provisions of the Licensing Law (Jersey) 1974, such applications were required to be put before a Parish Assembly for its consideration and for it to make a recommendation to the Licensing Assembly as to whether or not the application should be granted.

The application related to the transfer of ownership of the St Mary's Filling Station from the Channel Islands Co-Operative Society Ltd to Fuel Supplies (CI) Ltd. The Connétable advised that the requisite paperwork had been provided and that the application appeared to be in order from an administrative perspective.

Mr Mangematin advised that the shop would continue to operate as at present with a broadly similar product range. It would be closed for a few days in early October for changes to the shop layout and rebranding to take place.

There were no questions and it was then unanimously agreed that the Parish should recommend Fuel Supplies (CI) Ltd's application to the Licensing Assembly for approval.

The Connétable reminded Mr Mangematin that a representative of Fuel Supplies (CI) Ltd must attend the Royal Court at 10am on Thursday 25th September 2025, at which the licence application will be considered.

The Connétable declared the meeting closed at 7.03p.m
