Minutes of meeting on Thursday 16th October 2025 at 5:00pm

1.	The Minutes of the Meeting held on 17th July 2025 were approved.	
2.	<p>Matters Arising:</p> <p>With reference to road cleaning services, DJ reported that one parish had expressed potential interest in carrying these out and had asked the appropriate department to get in touch. We were waiting to hear further and whilst DJ was to chase, it was noted that we had already given instructions to existing contractor to carry out work in December.</p> <p>PleL advised that some potholing work had been carried out since the last meeting.</p> <p>The extra roundel had been painted in Rue es Boeufs.</p>	DJ
3.	The reports of the Roads Inspectors had been circulated and their contents were duly noted.	
4.	It was reported that the balance on the Roads Account as of 11 th October 2025 was approximately £59k.	
5.	<p><u>New Repairs and Signage Matters:</u></p> <p>There were no significant resurfacing projects identified at present but PleL would arrange for a pothole run to be conducted by the contractor.</p> <p>It was agreed that the account from the Infrastructure Department relating to the post extension required to accommodate the width restriction sign at the beginning of Rue du Couvent could be settled.</p>	PleL
6.	<p>It was duly noted that, in common with all parishes, Roads Committee and Inspectors elections were required to take place in December, the present terms of office expiring at the end of that month.</p> <p>In this connection, it was duly noted that PleL would not be seeking re-election for a further term and he was thanked for his many years of service in this role.</p> <p>DJ was requested to liaise with the Parish Secretary as to the date for these elections which would then be publicised in the usual manner.</p>	
7.	<p><u>Any Other Business</u></p> <p>Chemin de Catel – Reference was made to the situation on Chemin du Catel where the gradient and layout made it difficult for vehicles egressing the Fort to turn right. It was agreed that there was no responsibility to on the Parish but that the matter could be raised with the National Trust as to whether they had any proposals.</p>	PR

	The Chef de Police had enquired about the possibility of new road signs on entering the parish from St Peter opposite St Mary's Village/Clos de l'Arsenal but as to which DJ advised he would check with the Infrastructure department as to whether they had already agreed to provide these.	DJ
