**MINUTES OF NOMINATION MEETING
HELD AT ST MARY'S PARISH HALL
On 3rd FEBRUARY 2026 AT 7.30PM**

Pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated 9th January, 2026 whereby it was ordered that an election be held for the election of a Procureur in the Parish of St Mary to fill the vacancy occasioned by the expiry of the term of office of David Munns, and in conformity with the Procureurs du Bien Public (Terms of Office) (Jersey) Law 2013 and the Elections (Jersey) Law 2002, an Assembly of Electors was held at St Mary's Parish Hall on Tuesday 3rd February, 2026 at 7.30pm to receive nominations for the role.

The Connétable opened the Meeting by welcoming all. The Meeting was attended by 30 people who were confirmed as Electors in the Parish.

The Connétable thanked David Munns for the exceptional service he had given to the Parish in various roles, including in Honorary Police, Rates Assessment Committee and most recently, Procureur, spanning over five decades.

The Connétable then asked for nominations for the role of Procureur for the three-year term ending in March, 2029.
