Minutes of an Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St Mary held at St Mary's Parish Hall on Tuesday 10th March, 2026 at 7.30pm.

**WELCOME**

The Connétable, David Johnson, opened the meeting by welcoming all present. The notice convening the meeting was taken as read. The meeting was attended by 13 persons eligible to vote.

**1. Approval of Minutes**

The Minutes of the Parish Assembly held on 3rd February, 2026 had been made available on the Parish website and to those attending the Meeting. They were duly approved on a proposition put by Mr G Bower, seconded by Mr C Bunt.

The election of a new Roads Inspector dealt with at that Meeting was occasioned by the retirement of Mr Emile Drean from that role, a position he had held for in excess of ten years. The Connétable expressed the Parish's appreciation of Mr Emile Drean's service as Roads Inspector and wished him well in retirement.

**2. Election of a Constable's Officer Vingtaine du Sud for a three year term to take effect from 13th March, 2026.**
